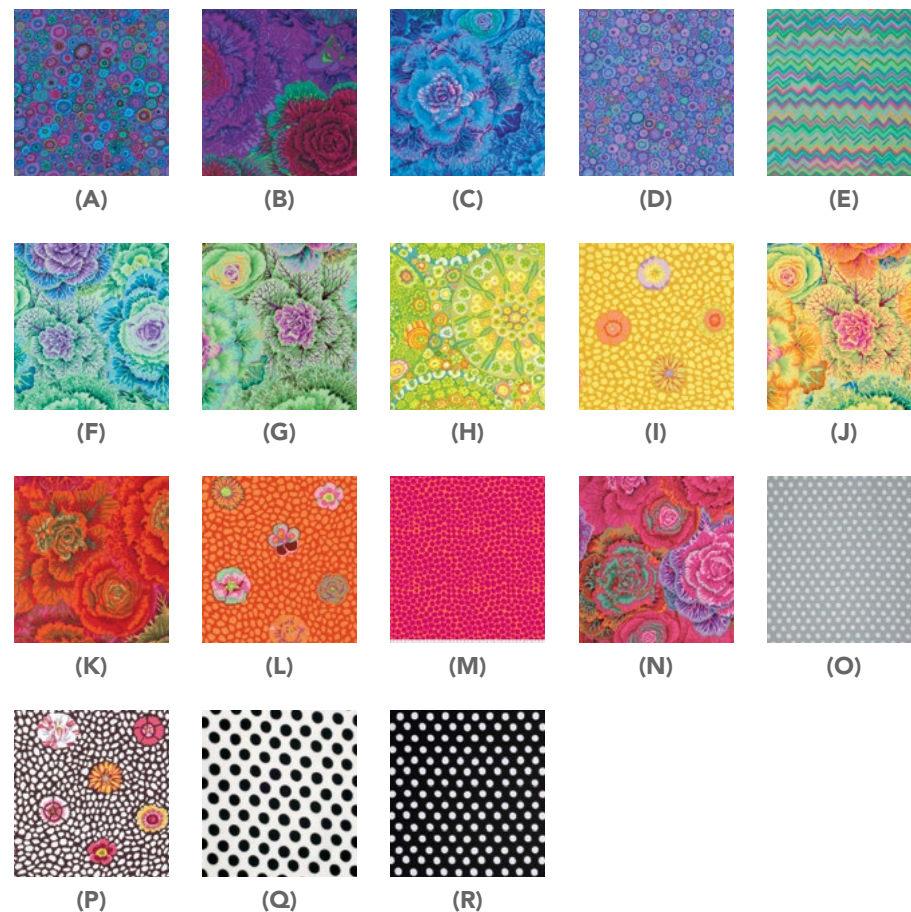

Additional Requirements

- The Kaffe Collective Aurifil thread 100% cotton 50wt



Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric; HST = Half Square Triangle

Note: If you received the fabric for the entire quilt top at one time, first cut **Fabrics A-N** into strips $4\frac{3}{4}"$ x WOF. Follow all further cutting instructions as listed.

Fabrics B, D, F, H, J, L and N, cut:

(1) $4\frac{3}{4}"$ (12.07cm) square

Fabric O, cut:

(2) $3\frac{1}{2}"$ x WOF (8.89cm x WOF) strips; **set aside (1) strip for Week 5**

Fabric Q:

From the partial $3\frac{7}{8}"$ (9.84cm) strip **set aside in Week 2**; sub-cut (2) $3\frac{7}{8}"$ (9.84cm) squares, and cut along one diagonal into (4) HSTs

Fabric R, cut:

From (2) $3\frac{7}{8}"$ (9.84cm) strips **set aside in Week 2**; sub-cut (12) $3\frac{7}{8}"$ (9.84cm) squares, and cut along one diagonal into (24) HSTs

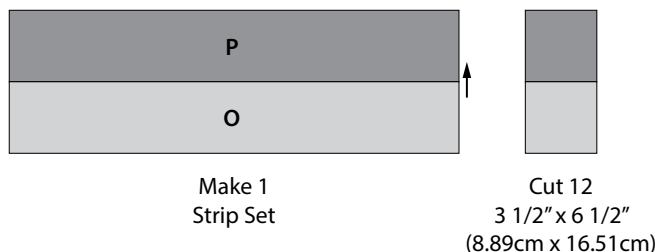
Instructions

All seam allowances are $\frac{1}{4}"$ (.64cm) and pieces are sewn right sides together.

Four Patch Blocks

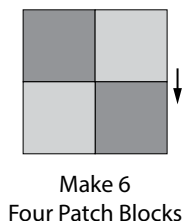
1. Sew a $3\frac{1}{2}"$ (8.89cm) **Fabric P** strip **set aside in Week 2** and a **Fabric O** strip together along one long edge. Press towards **Fabric P**. Cut (12) $3\frac{1}{2}"$ x $6\frac{1}{2}"$ (8.89cm x 16.51cm) units. (Fig. 1)

2. Sew (2) $3\frac{1}{2}"$ x $6\frac{1}{2}"$ (8.89cm x 16.51cm) units together, rotating so fabrics alternate, matching the seams, and pressing the seam allowances to one side. Repeat to make (6) four patch blocks ($6\frac{1}{2}"$ (16.51cm) square). (Fig. 2)

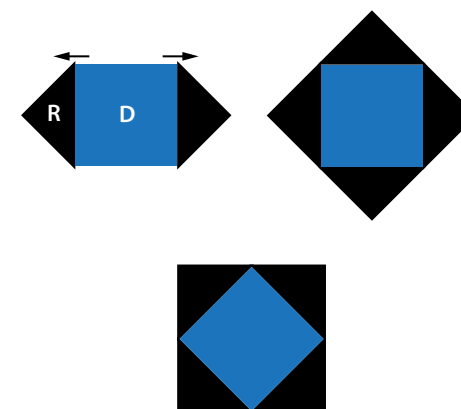

Square in a Square Blocks

3. Sew a **Fabric R** HST to 2 opposite sides of a $4\frac{3}{4}"$ (12.07cm) **Fabric D** square, centering the triangles on the square. Press the seam allowances towards the triangles. Sew **Fabric R** HSTs to the top and bottom of the **Fabric D** square to make (1) **Fabric D** Square in a Square Block ($6\frac{1}{2}"$ (16.51cm) square). (Fig. 3)

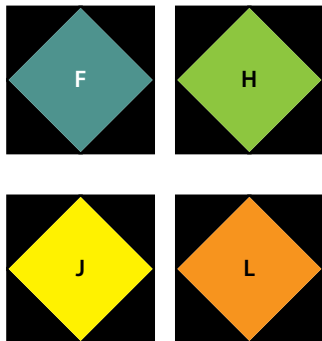

4. Repeat Step 3 using **Fabric R** HSTs and $4\frac{3}{4}$ " (12.07cm) squares to make (1) each **Fabric F, H, J** and **L** Square in a Square Block. (**Fig. 4**)

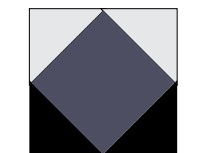
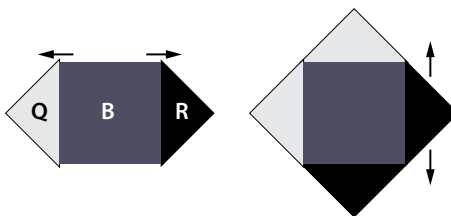

5. Sew a **Fabric Q** HST to the left side of a $4\frac{3}{4}$ " (12.07) **Fabric B** square and a **Fabric R** HST to the right side. Press the seam allowances towards the triangles. Sew a **Fabric Q** HST to the top and a **Fabric R** HST to the bottom of the square to make a **Fabric B** Square in a Square Block ($6\frac{1}{2}$ " (16.51cm) square). (**Fig. 5**)

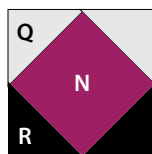

6. Repeat Step 5 to make (1) **Fabric N** Square in a Square Block. (**Fig. 6**)

Assembly

7. Sew together the **Fabric B, D, F, H, J, L** and **N** Square in a Square blocks alternating with the (6) Four Patch Blocks into a column ($6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $78\frac{1}{2}$ " (16.51cm x 199.39cm)). Press. (**Fig. 7**)

Label piece Week 4 and set aside.
