## Rainbow Star <br> Bold Colorway - Week 4

## Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric; HST = Half Square Triangle

Note: If you received the fabric for the entire quilt top at one time, first cut Fabrics A-N into strips $4^{3} / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF. Follow all further cutting instructions as listed.

Fabrics B, D, F, H, J, L and N, cut:
(1) $4^{3 / 4 "}(12.07 \mathrm{~cm})$ square

Fabric O, cut:
(2) $3^{1} 12^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF ( $8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) strips; set aside (1) strip for Week 5

## Fabric $\mathbf{Q}$ :

From the partial $3^{7 / 8^{\prime \prime}}(9.84 \mathrm{~cm})$ strip set aside in Week 2; sub-cut (2) $3^{7} / 8^{\prime \prime}(9.84 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares, and cut along one diagonal into (4) HSTs

Fabric R, cut:
From (2) $\mathbf{3}^{7 / 8 \prime} \mathbf{8}^{\prime \prime}(9.84 \mathrm{~cm})$ strips set aside in Week 2; sub-cut (12) $3^{7 / 8^{\prime \prime}}(9.84 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares, and cut along one diagonal into (24) HSTs

## Instructions

All seam allowances are $1 / 411(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ and pieces are sewn right sides together.

## Four Patch Blocks

1. Sew a $3^{11 / 2 \prime \prime}(8.89 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric $P$ strip set aside in Week 2 and a Fabric $\mathbf{O}$ strip together along one long edge. Press towards Fabric P. Cut (12) $3^{1 / 21} \times x$ $\mathbf{6}^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$ units. (Fig. 1)

2. Sew (2) $3^{1 / 21 \prime} \times 6^{1 / 12 \prime}(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$ units together, rotating so fabrics alternate, matching the seams, and pressing the seam allowances to one side. Repeat to make (6) four patch blocks ( $6^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime \prime}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$ square). (Fig. 2)

## Square in a Square Blocks

3. Sew a Fabric R HST to 2 opposite sides of a $4^{3 / 4^{\prime \prime}}$ $(12.07 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric $D$ square, centering the triangles on the square. Press the seam allowances towards the triangles. Sew Fabric $\mathbf{R}$ HSTs to the top and bottom of the Fabric $D$ square to make (1) Fabric D Square in a Square Block ( $6^{1} 2^{\prime \prime}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$ square).(Fig. 3)

4. Repeat Step 3 using Fabric R HSTs and $\mathbf{4}^{3 / 4} \mathbf{4}^{\prime \prime}$ $(12.07 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares to make (1) each Fabric F, H, J and L Square in a Square Block. (Fig. 4)

5. Sew a Fabric $\mathbf{Q}$ HST to the left side of a $\mathbf{4}^{3 / 4 \prime \prime}$ (12.07) Fabric B square and a Fabric R HST to the right side. Press the seam allowances towards the triangles. Sew a Fabric $\mathbf{Q}$ HST to the top and a Fabric R HST to the bottom of the square to make a Fabric B Square in a Square Block ( $\mathbf{6}^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) square). (Fig. 5)

6. Repeat Step 5 to make (1) Fabric $\mathbf{N}$ Square in a Square Block. (Fig. 6)

## Assembly

7. Sew together the Fabric B, D, F, H, J, L and N Square in a Square blocks alternating with the (6) Four Patch Blocks into a column ( $6^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x}$ $78^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 199.39 \mathrm{~cm})$ ). Press.(Fig. 7)

Label piece Week 4 and set aside.
