Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric; HST = Half Square Triangle

Note: If you received the fabric for the entire quilt top at one time, first cut **Fabrics A-N** into strips $4\%'' \times WOF$. Follow all further cutting instructions as listed.

Fabrics B, D, F, H, J, L and N, cut: (1) *A*³/⁴/⁴ (12.07cm) square

(1) **4**³/₄" (12.07cm) square

Fabric O, cut:

(2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF (8.89cm x WOF) strips; set aside (1) strip for Week 5

Fabric Q:

From the partial 3⁷/₈" (9.84cm) strip **set aside in Week 2**; sub-cut (2) 3⁷/₈" (9.84cm) squares, and cut along one diagonal into (4) HSTs

Fabric R, cut:

From (2) 3⁷/₆" (9.84cm) strips **set aside in Week 2**; sub-cut (12) 3⁷/₆" (9.84cm) squares, and cut along one diagonal into (24) HSTs

Instructions

Four Patch Blocks

 Sew a 3½" (8.89cm) Fabric P strip set aside in Week
 and a Fabric O strip together along one long edge. Press towards Fabric P. Cut (12) 3½" x
 6½" (8.89cm x 16.51cm) units. (Fig. 1)



3. Sew a **Fabric R** HST to 2 opposite sides of a **4**³/₄"

Square in a Square Blocks

(12.07cm) Fabric D square, centering the triangles on the square. Press the seam allowances towards the triangles. Sew Fabric R HSTs to the top and bottom of the Fabric D square to make (1) Fabric D Square in a Square Block (6¹/₂" (16.51cm) square).(Fig. 3)

2. Sew (2) 3¹/₂" x 6¹/₂" (8.89cm x 16.51cm) units together,

rotating so fabrics alternate, matching the seams,

Repeat to make (6) four patch blocks ($6\frac{1}{2}$ " (16.51cm)

and pressing the seam allowances to one side.




Make 6 Four Patch Blocks



 Repeat Step 3 using Fabric R HSTs and 4³/₄" (12.07cm) squares to make (1) each Fabric F, H, J and L Square in a Square Block. (Fig. 4)



Make 1 of each Square in a Square Block

 Sew a Fabric Q HST to the left side of a 4³/₄" (12.07)
 Fabric B square and a Fabric R HST to the right side. Press the seam allowances towards the triangles. Sew a Fabric Q HST to the top and a Fabric R HST to the bottom of the square to make a Fabric B Square in a Square Block (6¹/₂" (16.51cm) square). (Fig. 5)

Make 1 Square in a Square Block

 Repeat Step 5 to make (1) Fabric N Square in a Square Block. (Fig. 6)

Make 1 Square in a Square Block

Assembly

 Sew together the Fabric B, D, F, H, J, L and N Square in a Square blocks alternating with the (6) Four Patch Blocks into a column (6¹/₂" x 78¹/₂" (16.51cm x 199.39cm)). Press.(Fig. 7)

Label piece Week 4 and set aside.


