## Cutting

WOF = Width of Fabric; HST = Half Square Triangle
Fabrics A, C, E, G, I, K and M cut:
(1) $4^{3 / 4 "} \times$ WOF ( $12.07 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) strip; sub-cut
(7) $4^{3 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime}(12.07 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares

Fabrics B, D, F, H, J, L and N, cut:
(1) $43^{3 / 4} \times$ WOF ( $12.07 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) strip; sub-cut
(6) $43^{3 \prime \prime}(12.07 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares

Fabric O, cut:
(6) $3^{11 / 2 "} \times$ WOF $(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF $)$ strips

Fabric P , cut:
(6) $4^{3 / 4 "} \times$ WOF ( $12.07 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) strips; sub-cut
(42) $4^{3 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime}(12.07 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares
(6) $3^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF $(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF $)$ strips

Fabric Q, cut:
(13) $3^{71 / 8 "} \times$ WOF ( $9.84 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) strips; sub-cut
(122) $3^{7 / 8^{\prime \prime}}(9.84 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares, cut along one diagonal into (244) HSTs

## Fabric R, cut:

(15) $\mathbf{3}^{7 / 8 "} \times$ WOF ( $9.84 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) strips; sub-cut
(144) $3^{77} 8^{\prime \prime \prime}(9.84 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares, cut along one diagonal into
(288) HSTs
(9) $\mathbf{2}^{1 ⁄ 12^{\prime \prime}} \times$ WOF ( $6.35 \times$ WOF) strips for binding

## Instructions

All seam allowances are $1 / 411(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ and pieces are sewn right sides together.

## Four Patch Blocks

1. Sew (1) $\mathbf{3}^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}(8.89 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric $\mathbf{O}$ and $\mathbf{P}$ strip together along one long edge. Press towards Fabric P. Repeat with the remaining strips to make (6) strip sets. Cut (72) $3^{11 / 2 " \prime} \times 6^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$ units. (Fig. 1)

$31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ $(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$
2. Sew (2) $3^{11 / 2^{\prime \prime}} \times 6^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$ units together, rotating one so fabrics alternate. Match the seams and press the seam allowances to one side. Repeat to make (36) four patch blocks ( $6^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) square). (Fig. 2)

## Square in a Square Blocks

3. Sew a Fabric $\mathbf{Q}$ HST to two opposite sides of a $4^{3 / 4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ $(12.07 \mathrm{~cm})$ Fabric $\mathbf{A}$ square, centering the triangles on the square. Press the seam allowances towards the triangles. Sew Fabric $\mathbf{Q}$ HSTs to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square. Press the seam allowances towards the triangles. (Fig. 3) Repeat to make (7) Fabric A Square in a Square Blocks ( $6^{1 / 2 \prime 2}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$ square).

4. Repeat Step 3 using Fabric $\mathbf{Q}$ HSTs and $\mathbf{4}^{3 / 4 "}$
( 12.07 cm ) squares to make (7) each Fabric C, E, G, I, $\mathbf{K}$ and $\mathbf{M}$ Square in a Square Blocks. (Fig. 4)

5. Repeat Step 3 using Fabric $\mathbf{R}$ HSTs and $\mathbf{4}^{3 / 4} \mathbf{4}^{\prime \prime}$
$(12.07 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares to make (6) each Fabric D, F, H, $\mathbf{J}$ and $\mathbf{L}$ Square in a Square Blocks and (30) Fabric $\mathbf{P}$ Square in a Square Block 1. (Fig. 5)

6. Sew a Fabric $\mathbf{Q}$ HST to the left side of a $\mathbf{4}^{3} / \mathbf{m}^{\prime \prime}$ (12.07)

Fabric B square and a Fabric R HST to the right side. Press the seam allowances towards the triangles. Sew a Fabric Q HST to the top and a Fabric R HST to the bottom of the square. (Fig. 6) Repeat to make (6) Fabric B Square in a Square Blocks ( $6^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$ square).

7. Repeat Step 6 to make (6) Fabric $\mathbf{N}$ Square in a Square Blocks and (12) Fabric P Square in a Square Block 2. (Fig. 7)

## Quilt Top Assembly

Note: Follow the Quilt Layout diagram for fabric placement while assembling the quilt. All rows should measure $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 78^{1 / 2 "}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 199.39 \mathrm{~cm})$
8. Sew together (6) Four Patch Blocks alternating with (5) Fabric P Square in a Square Block 1. Sew a Fabric P Square in a Square Block 2 to both ends. Press the seam allowances towards the Four Patch Blocks. Repeat to make (6) Four Patch Rows.
9. Sew together (7) Fabric A Square in a Square Blocks alternating with (6) Fabric B Square in a Square Blocks to make Row 1. Press the seam allowances towards the Fabric A Blocks.
10. Repeat Step 9 with Fabric C and D Blocks for Row 2, Fabric E and F Blocks for Row 3, Fabric G and H Blocks for Row 4, Fabric I and J Blocks for Row 5, Fabric $\mathbf{K}$ and $\mathbf{L}$ Blocks for Row 6 and Fabric $\mathbf{M}$ and $\mathbf{N}$ Blocks for Row 7
11. Sew together the (7) Rows alternating with the (6) Four Patch Rows to complete the Quilt Top (781/2" ( 199.39 cm ) square).

## Finishing

12. Sew together the (9) $2^{1 / 1 / 2^{\prime \prime}} \times \operatorname{WOF}$ ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ WOF) Fabric $\mathbf{R}$ binding strips end to end using diagonal seams. Press seams open. Press the binding strip in half wrong sides together.
13. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together and quilt as desired. Trim excess batting and backing even with the top after quilting is completed.
14. Leaving an $8^{\prime \prime}(20.32 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail of binding, sew the binding to the top of the quilt through all layers matching all raw edges. Miter corners. Stop approximately 12 " $(30.48 \mathrm{~cm})$ from where you started. Lay both loose ends of binding flat along quilt edge. Where the loose ends meet, fold them back on themselves and press to form a crease. Using this crease as your stitching line, sew the two open ends of the binding right sides together. Trim seam to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}(.64 \mathrm{~cm})$ and press open. Finish sewing binding to quilt.
15. Turn the binding to the back of quilt and hand-stitch in place.
